TOBACCO ORDER, 2005

Prohibition of smoking.

14. (2) Any person who smokes in any specified place or specified vehicle in contravention of subsection (1) is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.

"smoking" means inhaling and expelling the smoke of tobacco or any other substance and includes the holding of any cigar, cigarette, pipe or any other form of tobacco product which is alight or emitting smoke;

"tobacco product" means a cigarette, cigar or any other form of tobacco including any mixture containing tobacco;

Eight fined \$300 each for smoking, vaping at a Beribi cafe

EIGHT people were each fined \$300 recently after they were caught smoking cigarettes and e-cigarettes at a cafe in Beribi during enforcement operations conducted by the Ministry of Health (MoH) earlier this month.

The offenders – four men and four women – were aged 18 to 33.

In a press statement issued yesterday, MoH reminded the public that smoking – including the use of e-cigarettes – is prohibited in restaurants, cafes and other eateries, including any outdoor areas, as stated in one of the conditions under the Tobacco

MoH in its statement reiterated that the use of e-cigarettes falls within the definition of "smoking" under the Tobacco Order 2005.

Managers of restaurants, cafes and other eateries who fail or neglect their duties in complying with the regulations by allowing customers to smoke within their business premises will be guilty of an offence and can be compounded for up to \$500.

In its statement, MoH said 132 people were compounded from early this year until the end of June for smoking offences in public places.
